1. Meeting with Parents

I organized a meeting with the College parents to discuss issues to do with the Online Learning. 2. Reopening of Schools

As you are probably all aware, the government recently stated the dates for the reopening of schools; the 15th of March for Examination Classes and 22nd of March for non-examination classes.

Teachers and students at Hillcrest have been doing online learning from the 12th of January. We are aware that students, parents, and teachers **will require a break** from the pressures of a 12-week term (online and soon to be face to face learning). It is also possible that some parents will have made plans for the Easter holidays.

ATS is applying to the Ministry of Education for a deviation from what has been stated to allow all students to return on the 15th of March and for our term dates to remain as was originally set out at the beginning of the year i.e. first term ends on the 31st of March and Term two starts on the 3rd of May. This application will be submitted today, and we will keep you informed as to its outcome.
