Dear Parents & Guardians,

After consultation with ATS, Hillcrest Schools will postpone the planned eLearning phase which was scheduled to start on Tuesday 29th June, 2021. We will, therefore, inform you when we will resume online lessons in due course.

That being said, parents are asked to ensure that children are prepared for the possible eLearning session. For the eLearning that is likely to take place you will need suitable devices, access to the internet for prolonged periods, a suitable place to work free of disturbance and supervision. For examination classes, students are encouraged to ensure they prepare themselves well for their coming examinations. Time is moving and they will not have the time for revision at the start of the third term they would usually have had.
