3. AS/AL Cambridge Results

Cambridge released the results from the 2021 'AS' and 'A' Level November Cambridge examinations this past Monday. Overall, I am pleased with the results and would like to commend our teachers and students who have worked under difficult conditions to achieve the following results.

For the 'AS' Cambridge examinations we had a 91% pass rate with 7 subjects recording a 100% pass rate.

For the 'A' Level Cambridge examinations we had a 95% subject pass rate with 10 subjects recording a 100% pass rate.

4. IGCSE Results

The IGCSE results are coming out on **Monday 17th January**. We will start to issue these out at **9.00am** for those that can come to school.
