1. New Parents' & Students' Meeting & Orientation

You may, therefore, leave your children (boarders) with enough money to pay for one or two House T-Shirts at the Tuck Shop when they know to which house they belong.

6. Payment of School Fees

The Office will be open on Sunday 6th February between 9.00am and 4.00pm to receive payments. Please be advised that students will not be allowed access into the Hostel or into the Classroom without a valid School Fees Pass.

7. Signing into Hostel

Boarders will be expected into Hostel by 4.30pm to allow for settling in and preparing for the start of school on the next day. I implore parents to travel ahead of time and avoid late travelling.
